DUTRAC YOUTH SAVE \$1.7 MILLION AND WIN NATIONAL YOUTH SAVING CHALLENGE™

DuTrac's younger members took to heart the theme of "Unleash the Power of Saving at your Credit Union™ to save \$1.7 million and win the 2023 National Youth Saving Challenge™. The Credit Union National Association (CUNA) headquartered in Washington, D.C., reported savings of \$15.2 million by the nation's youth during the National Youth Savings Month of April.

DuTrac encouraged younger members to save wisely through the credit union's scholarships, deposit savings bonus promotions through the Savasaurus Kids Club, financial education, and events for youth members of all ages. CUNA offered a grand prize of \$1,000 to create ten (10) youth awards worth \$100 each to encourage participation in the program. DuTrac was selected as the grand-prize winner. 

Members must remain in their vehicle (pull up, open trunk or doors) and let Tri-State Shred staff remove shred. A maximum of three grocery bags per vehicle is allowed.

DuTrac will also have secure shred containers at most offices from October 16 to 20 (excluding Walmart, Asbury, and Bettendorf). One grocery bag per member, and members must place shreds in the bin.

HOW TO PREVENT ACCOUNT TAKEOVER FRAUD

Account Takeover Fraud is a type of identity theft where fraudsters obtain online credentials, take over an account and make unauthorized transactions and changes, and/or sell the verified credentials.

Once the scammer logs into your account, they can change account information (username, password, email, etc.), lock you out from your own account and then compromise personal information masquerading as you. They further commit identity theft by using your personal information to commit fraud or other crimes.

Prevent Online Account Takeover

- #1. Never give anyone you do not know access to your devices.
- #2. Never share online banking login details or passwords with anyone.



What they do

If someone is asking to access any of your devices and wants you to download specific software, you are at risk of becoming a victim of a remote access scam. These criminals will call and report a computer or internet problem they have detected and offer to help. They may even say they work for a widely-known company or even your credit union. They may go as far as stating they have your credit union on the phone to assist in protecting your money. **DO NOT trust the "help" offered that you did not request!**

What you can do

Scammers want your money. If someone who is remotely connected to your device is asking you to login to your credit union account or share personal passwords, they are a scammer. Do not follow their instructions. Even if they say you need to pay them because they allegedly solved the problem you were having, don't trust them. You didn't ask for their "help."

STOP any phone call by hanging up. END any remote session by turning off your device.

If this happens to you, protect yourself by taking the following steps:

- 1. Report the scam to you credit union.
- 2. Have your device checked by an IT-specialist.
- 3. Change passwords, username and account security information to accounts that may have been compromised.
- 4. Report the scam to your local authorities.
